KUNR is a self-supporting entity whose primary revenues come from listener contributions, business underwriting and grants. The station has broadcast from the University of Nevada, Reno, campus since 1963, and is licensed to the Nevada System of Higher Education. KUNR's engaging blend of public radio is heard 24 hours a day throughout a vast area of northern Nevada and northeastern California — as far north as Susanville, as far south as Bishop, and east-west from Truckee to Elko. Covering more than 106,000 square miles, KUNR has one of the largest service areas in the U.S., made possible by 14 translators in rural areas and its sister station, KNCC, in Elko. More than 40,000 listeners tune in weekly.
